The abovenamed has lodged a claim for a service pension and the question of whether this ex-serviceman served in a Theatre of War is under investigation.

- 2. An entry on Army Form B.103 indicates that he was stationed at Camp Pell N.T., on 3rd April, 1943. However, entries immediately before or after this time would imply that this entry could be erroneous. Assuming it is incorrect it would appear that claimant first entered the prescribed area in the Northern Territory on 29th October, 1943.
 - 3. Please furnish particulars of Mr. Blackmore's service in the Northern Territory, north of 14.5° south latitude during the period 19.2.42 to 12.11.43.

The ex-member served with 25 Aust Employment Company, Adelaide River detachment, with effect from 29th October 1943. His unit was located at Adelaide River on and after 12th November 1943.

It should be noted that Camp Pell Army Camp, referred to in your memorandum, was located approximately three miles from Melbourne.
