

AWARDED THE MILITARY CROSS

" HIS MAJESTY THE KING has been graciously pleased to confer the Military Cross on the undermentagned officer, in recognition of his gallantry and devotion to duty in the Field :-

Lieutenant VICTOR DENSON BOWEN.

By his daring personal recommaissance and constant supervision of all routes he secured for his brigade an unbroken system of communication. Although on two occasions rendered unconscious and badly shaken by the explosion of a shell, his maked determination and disregard of danger communicated itself to all connected with him. On one occasion in particular he went out in front through a hostile barrage to re-establish communications between our radding party and headquarters, thereby greatly assisting the success of the operations.
