Dear Sir,

I understand from a report in a local newspaper that it is the intention of the appropriate Minister to issue a medallion and lapel badge for those who served in the Gallipoli Campaign.

Should such be the case I would like my name recorded for such.

Your Department would have a record of paying me a military pension since 1915.

I lost all my military records in a shipwreck some years ago.

My regemental number was 5443, the regement was 4th Company A.A.S.C.

I enlisted at Morphettville, South Australia.

The regement was camped at Heliopolis, Egypt, from where we went to Anzac Cove Gallipoli.

My brother Charles Alfred Campbell since deceased accompanied me. No 5611 94HR

A man named Denford of the same regement died beside me on the beach at Anzac Cove about May 1915.

I was first invalided to England as all hospitals had to be cleared owing to the projected Suvla Bay landing and the anticipated casualties.

From Weymouth England I was sent back to South Australia where I was operated on at the Keswick Military Hospital by a Captain Rice who was a surgeon.

I was discharge later in 1915 and have drawn a military pension ever since.

My duties on Gallipoli were escort for Mule convoys mainly up Shrapnel Gully to the reserves and front lines with food, water and ammunition supplies.

I did bring back from Gallipoli the personal belongings of deceased Denford to his relatives in South Australia, which I remember included a wrist watch.

I believe Denford was buried in the open country between the beach and Shrapnel Gully, and I believe I attended his burial which took place in the hours of darkness owing to the exposed nature of this area to the Turks.

The object of the foregoing was to establish some proof that I did serve on Gallipoli.

According to the records No.5611 Driver Charles Alfred Campbell enlisted at Oaklands, S.A., on 22/12/14, and embarked from Adelaide per A.17 "Port Lincoln" 1/4/15; he was subsequently returned to Australia "Wiltshire", 25/9/15 (V.D.), B.R.29/7, and was transferred to Broadmeadows for duty 12/1/15. Memo 4th M.D. 42/370/1007 of 14/6/16 states returned ex "Wiltshire" (V.D.), discharged 4th M.D. 9/6/16. B.R.50/49. This information is evidently incorrect and is cancelled in B.R.71, as our records show him as having re-embarked per "Kabinga" from Melbourne 6/5/16 as Driver with 17th Reinforcements, 12th A.S.C.

The original Attestation Sheet for No.5443 Driver Clarence Hart Campbell is not held at this office, but his records show that he embarked from Melbourne on 19/2/15, A.54 "Runio", and that he was subsequently returned to Australia "Runio" 21/12/15 - Fractured Left Tibia. B.R.30/51, and was discharged 4th M.D. (M.U.), 9/6/16. Memo 4th M.D., S.O.R.S., 9/6/16, B.R.48/30.

The above named soldiers are apparently not identical.
