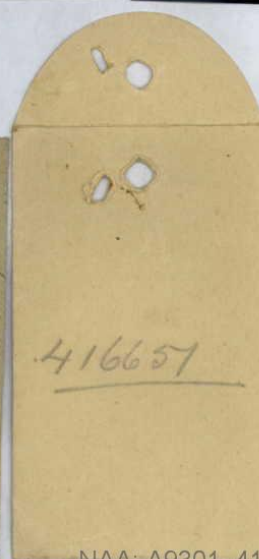
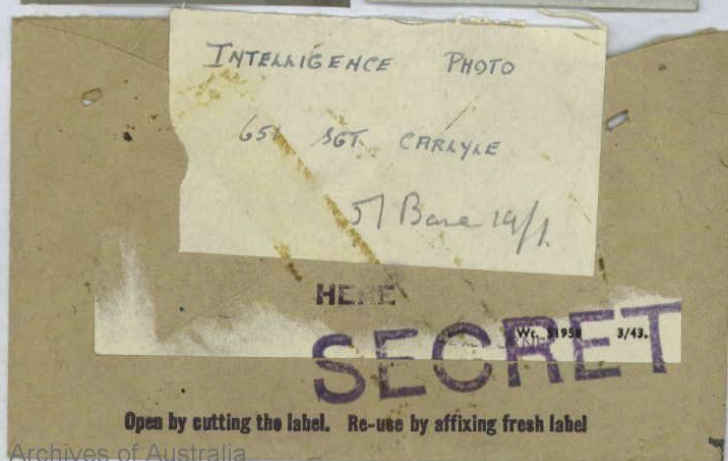
Dear Sir,
