With further reference to the burial of your son, the late No.4405 Private A.G. CRETTENDEN, 27th Battalion, I have to inform you that according to the latest progress report to hand from the Imperial War Graves Commission the erection of permanent headstones in the WARLENCOURT BRITISH CEMETERY is now being proceeded with, and generally the work of re-construction has reached an advanced stage.

In order to conform with the uniform layout of this Cemetery the following official registration has been allotted to the site of the late soldier's final resting place, viz:-
