A key objective of the stracking troops was the capture of the Suprised Salent, a small but heavily reinforced section of the German line north-west of Fromelies. The strack was originally planned for 17 July and the preliminary artillery bombardment.

The attack made little impact on German troop movements toward the Somme and is now seen as a casely failure. In just over one sight of fighting, over 5,300 Australian and more than 1,500 British soldlers were silved, wounded or captured. The Bastic of Fromeise was the first major deployment of an Australian Division on the Western Front and the only one in which none of the original objectives were achieved.
