With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your son, the late 2nd Lieutenant E. Cutts, 32nd Battalion, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he died at 5th Casualty Clearing Station, France, on 3/6/18 of wounds (shell wounds legs) received in action, and was buried on the following day in British Military cemetery, Crouy, France.

The utmost care and attention is being devoted where possible to the graves of our soldiers. It is understood photographs of graves are being taken as soon as is possible and these will be transmitted to next-of-kin when available.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connexion with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.
