Dunstone, 5th Machine Gun Battalion was on 25.5.17 admitted to 1st Australian Dermatological Hospital (V.D) and was discharged to Training Depot on 22.8.17, Total period (V.D) 90 days. On 5.11.17, he was sentenced to 39 days detention for being Absent Without Leave from 25.8.17 to 12.9.17.

In view of your representations the matter has been referred to A.I.F. Headquarters, London, for investigation, and when the reply is to hand, you will be again communicated with.

The following copy of a communication dated 8th instant, received from Mr. H. T. Dunstone, "Leura", Gloucester Street, Prospect, South Australia, concerning No. 416 Lance Corporal A. M. Dunstone, 5th Machine Gun Battalion, is referred for favor of attention :-

" I wish to draw your attention to an inaccuracy in Base Records concerning the abovenamed man and make the following statements with the full knowledge and assurance that they are true -

In Base Records List No. 118 issued from Melbourne it states :- 416 Lance Corporal A.M. Dunstone 90 days absent (V.D). This record is incorrect. The abovementioned man has never been in hospital for V.D.

Briefly the facts are, he was A.W.L. approximately 3 weeks during the period - end of August and beginning of September 1917, from Park House Camp, Salisbury Plains. On returning to Park House Camp he found same vacated by his unit, and reported himself to Grantham (M.G.School) remaining undiscovered until about 9th October; was awaiting trial between period 9th October till 5th November 1917, when he was awarded 39 days detention. I may further state that I personally saw the announcement of the trial by D.C.M. in Tidworth Orders (A.I.F.Depots in U.K.) to take place on 5th November, 1917, and 2 weeks later received an official memo. stating he had been awarded 39 days detention, and had been transferred to Gosport Detention Barracks.

The error in Records has occurred either in London or Melbourne, and a base injustice, and unnecessary slur cast upon the character of one, though not entirely free from blame, is innocent of the foul slander implied by Base Records List No.118.

I therefore ask that due enquiries be made, and the mistake rectified at the earliest possible moment.

Thanking you in anticipation, and trusting your early reply will enable me to dispel any remaining doubts from the minds of his distressed parents. "

According to London Order No.1 of 1917, he was on 25.5.17 admitted to 1st A.D.H.(VD) and discharged to Training Depot on 22.8.17, total period 90 days. London Order No.48 of 1917 shows that he was on 5.11.17 sentenced to 39 days detention for being A.W.L. from 23.8.17 till 12.9.17.
