Opinion of the Medical Board.

Norse — (i.) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Board, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

- (ii.) Expressions such as "may," "might," "probably," &c., should be avoided.
- (iii.) The rates of pension vary directly according to whether the disability is, (a) caused or aggravated by service in the present war, (b) due to causes not connected with present war, vis. (1) earlier active service, (2) climatic disease in pre-war service, (3) or linary military service before the war. It is, therefore, essential when assigning the cause of a divibility to differentiate between them.
