He was buried in Pont D'Achelles British Cemetery, Nieppe, three miles North West of Armentieres.

The u most cars and attention is being devoted to the graves of our fallen soldiers, and photographs are being taken as soon as spssible for transmission to next-of-kin.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.


