#### Opinion of the Medical Board

Norms,—(i.) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Beard, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should, be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

- (ii.) Expressions such as "may," "might," "probably," &c., should be avoided.
- (iii) The rates of pension vary directly according to whether the disability is, (A) caused or aggravated by service in the present war, (a) due to couses not connected with present war, viz. (1) earlier active service, (2) elimatic discuse in pre-war service, (3) ordinary military service before the war. It is, therefore, essential when assigning the cause of a disability to differentiate between them
- (iv). In answering question 21 the Board should be careful to discriminate between disease resulting from military conditions and disease to which the soldier would have been equally liable in civil life.
