

Reference: Your MX187347 (EL8) of 30th October 1972.

It has now been possible to establish that Private HALL attended a camp of training at Woodside from 26th February 1941 to 8th March 1941. However, he did not attend a camp in December 1940.

The entry on his AF B103 "Attended Camp No. 21/1940 Woodside 89 days - 10/12/40" was possibly a Unit entry. His unit, the 48th Battalion was in camp from 10th December 1940 to 8th March 1941, a period of 89 days, but he was not.
