I was shipped down from Tullahoma Bend in 1931 by the S.A. Railway and while shipping we burnt a lot of papers and my Certificate must have got burnt with the papers as I cannot find it anywhere now. I have looked for it every where. That the loss of the said Discharge Certificate was unavoidable, and that to the best of my knowledge and belief such is not in the hands of any other person.

And I make this solemn declaration by virtue of the STATUTORY DECLARATIONS ACT 1911, conscientiously believing the statements contained therein to be true in every particular.
