*Wae Poole*Reference Injury to No 178 Cpl Poole E.

On the night 24.25th April 1918, Cpl Poole was on Outpost duty on Wadi Nimrin - He, with two Indian Lancers & horseholder formed a "Listening Post" - In the early hours of the morning of 25th his Post was attacked by about 30 of the enemy & one of the Lancer's horses killed. On making his way back to the Outpost Line Poole's horse stumbled & fell on him, whilst crossing some broken ground, causing an injury to his ankle. Capt J.T. Bigg was in charge of the Outpost line & reported the matter to me on returning to camp about 0800 the same morning.

On the morning of the 25th of April 1918 I was one of an outpost under Corporal E. Poole. Ours was No 1 post on the right bank of the Wadi Nimrin. At about 0300 our Post was attacked by about 30 of the enemy. After firing on them for a short time we were forced to leave our Post and acting under instructions from Capt Biggs who was in charge of the Outpost Line. We withdrew to a position about five hundred yards to the rear. While withdrawing Corporal Poole's horse fell in some rough ground injuring Cpl Poole's ankle. Corporal Poole then reported to Capt Biggs.

On the night of 24.4.18 I was in charge of No 3 outpost on the Northern side of Wadi Nimrin. Cpl Poole was in charge of No 1 post on the right of the troops sector and had with him No 114 Tpr Burzacott P. and two Indians.

At about 0305 on 25.4.18 the enemy about 30 strong raided No 1 post & Cpl Poole acting under instructions received from Capt J.T. Bigg withdrew to a position about 500 yards to the rear.

While proceeding over very rough ground, Cpl Poole's horse fell with him - injuring his ankle.

The matter was reported to Capt Bigg who was in charge of the Outpost.
