Mrs P.M. Smith, 53 Gloucester Street, Prospect, S.A. Dear Madam,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your husband, the late No. 2529B, Private W. S. Smith, 27th Battalion, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he was wounded in action in France on 8th August, 1918, and admitted to 6th Australian Field Ambulance suffering from shell wound head. He was then transferred to 20th Casualty Clearing Station, France, where he died on 10th idem as the result of his wounds. He was buried in Vignacourt British Cemetery eight miles North North West of Amiens.

The utmost care and attention is being devoted, where possible, to the graves of our soldiers. It is understood photographs are being taken as soon as practicable for transmission to next-of-kin.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.
