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Dear Madam,

In reply to yours of the 16th inst., which has been held up pending receipt of definite information from Egypt on the subject of your brother, the late No. 4082 Private L. A. Winzer, 2nd Australian Stationary Hospital, I regret very much that the advice now to hand seem to leave little doubt as to the accuracy of the reports previously supplied.

The Australian Intermediate Base, at Cairo, first reported that he had died of perforation on the 28th August and the Alexandria authorities subsequently stated that he died of phaeomania on the same date. This was queried and again the Alexandria authorities state that he is officially reported as having died of pneumonia at sea on the Hospital Ship "Neuralia" on the 28th August, and finally the same authority confirms the date, with the addition that the actual cause of death was "paraplegia". I understand, upon enquiries from our medical authorities, that the reports are quite consistent, the last specified resulting from brain paralysis, the result of pneumonia which nearly always follows on penetration about the lungs.
